IMPORTANT DATES

Halloween

Students may dress for Halloween the week of October 24th. There will be NO CLASS on Halloween, Monday, October 31st.

FUNDRAISERS

Sarris Candy orders are due Monday November 4th. Please make one check payable to MPAC for the total order. All orders must be picked up at the studio Monday December 5th between 3:00PM- 7:00PM.

COSTUMES

Students will be measured for costumes at the end of September.

Each student is required to submit a \$40 non-refundable deposit per costume for the recital. Costume deposits are due Monday October 3rd with full payment due November 1st.

The price of each costume will be listed on the board at the studio. Any costume not paid in full by the due date will have an additional \$10 charge per costume. Costume

payments are non-refundable and each parent must initial the measurement sheet to indicate approval of the size.

CHRISTMAS PARADES

The Crown Center Christmas parade will be Thursday November 17th at 6:00PM. Students will line up at the mall office no later than 5:45PM. Company members will perform in the mall immediately following the parade.

The Washington Christmas parade is Friday December 2nd at 7:00PM. Line up will be at 6:30 PM and all competitive students are required to participate. We will have a pizza party following if enough families are interested.

The Waynesburg Christmas parade will be held on Saturday December 3rd. Time and location will be posted on the studio board. All competitive students are required to participate and a pizza party will follow at the Waynesburg studio.

PARADE OUTFITS

All competitive dancers must wear the red Rockette dress with Santa hat, tan tights, black boots, white turtleneck and white gloves. Please make sure to layer for warmth. All students have the option of purchasing the dress. CWS students may wear a holiday costume or purchase a MPAC jog set. Jog sets are worn with white turtlenecks (layering for warmth) and white gloves, white boots or white tennis shoes and a Santa hat with a white knit hat underneath.
